NEW BUSINESS:

- --The Marshalltown Library has entered into a new partnership with the Ames Public Library to provide electronic periodical service through *ZINIO*. Both libraries will have access to additional titles and our cost should be reduced. The partnership is called Midlowa Magazines. Look for that link on the library's homepage.
- -- The library staff participated in a city in-service on Tuesday, November 11.
- --All library staff members are doing annual safety training.
- -- The Marshall County Library Association presented to the Board of Supervisors on November 18. The supervisors budget \$36,000 to fund all seven of the county libraries. Let your supervisors know how important library service is to county residents and that increased funding would be welcome!
- -- Enrich lowa funding has been received. These are state funds that we receive for providing service to patrons from outside of Marshall County.
- --The Library will be closed Thanksgiving Day and the day after Thanksgiving.
- --Recent programming includes an author visit and book signing by Patience Griffin, the November movie matinee, "Lady Eve", and the final presentation of the poverty symposium, "Inequality for All."
- --MHS Government students were welcomed.
