Board Meeting – February 22, 2011

Attending: Karen Elder, Maureen Lyons, Allan Thoreson, Barbara Burt, Glenn Ytzen, Glenda Davis-Driggs, Tom Colbert, Sandy Gowdy, 23 Government students, 2 private citizens, and member of the media.

President called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

The operating bills were reviewed. Board members found the new format easier to read. Barb Burt made a motion for approval of the bills. Tom Colbert seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Library Director, Glenda Davis-Driggs reviewed the policy on responsibility for collection selection. Policies regarding selection in various departments were updated to reflect current practice. Tom Colbert made a motion for acceptance of the policy changes. Glenn Ytzen seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- 2. Two quotes from companies proposing to install a flagpole outside the library were reviewed. The City's facility superintendent, Dave Daters recommended we go with a 30'x 6" pole with an internal winch and cable, lit by an LED light mounted high on the building. There are funds in the building funds to cover the cost estimated at \$2,800. The pole would be placed in the southwest or southeast corner of the property. Maureen Lyons made a motion that we accept the bid from Heartand Flagpoles and Custom Flags to install a 30' x 6" flagpole with internal winch and cable with LED lighting at a total cost of \$2,800.00. Glenn Ytzen seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved. Exact funding sources for this project will be finalized at our next meeting with probable installation in April.
- 3. Glenda presented information on yesterday's City Training Day. Library staff worked on fire safety issues and severe weather eventualities.
- 4. Glenda reported a member of Central Iowa Library Service Area offered her agencies services in helping the board and staff do long range planning.
- 5. Glenda presented information on usage of downloadable audio books and electronic books for the past three months. She announced the Friends of the Library recent book sale netted \$2,085.00
