- --Public Art: The library was part of a grant proposal that ultimately placed "Echo" on 13th Street and will place "Drill" at the MHS Roundhouse. The library did not receive that grant money, but the FOL had earmarked \$25,000 for a match. They are still interested in funding a piece(s) of public art, possibly for the library's 10th anniversary.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

- --City employees participated in an in-service on November 11. Included was ALICE training. Library staff used the afternoon for department projects.
- --The library will be closed Thanksgiving Day and Friday, November 25. It will be open Saturday and Sunday, November 26 and 27.
- --Many programs!!..Science-stravaganza, artist Gary Kelly, author/speaker Rosalind Wiseman. Upcoming events include the annual model train display and "stress relief" adult coloring.
- --The city's new city administrator, Jessica Kinser, began her job on Monday, November 14. She will attend a library board meeting within the next few months.
- --Additional and new collections include the "Lucky Day" collection and the growing "Welcome Center" materials. Looking for a vendor for the Launch Pads and to date, no sponsor has been found for the charging station.
