A: Summer Reading Update: About 1000 children participated in summer reading. This number does not include day camp participants. Beanstack statistics were able to show levels of participation by how many days of reading were done and age groups within each school. Adults were able to participate in summer reading either on-line or on paper. 154 participants read 488 books.

- *B:* Staffing Update: A library clerk has resigned, so there is an opening for a library services clerk. Cherie Weaver has been hired as the Outreach Coordinator. She will begin October 5.
- *C:* Bookmobile Update: Supply delays have once again caused delays, so the completion date has been estimated at the end of October or into November. Photos show the interior and exterior as well as the placement of the awning and screen. The new Outreach Coordinator is a professional artist and will meet with Keeley (Sign Creations) on ideas for the wrap. They will wait for delivery for final measurements. Cherie will be learning the system and will aid in sharing and producing documents for the bookmobile.
